Seokguram Grotto, the greatest masterpiece of the golden age of Silla, is a heritage property in which architecture, mathematical principles, geometry, religion, and art are collectively realized through its design and construction.



The construction of Bulguksa Temple was begun by Gim Daeseong in 751 A.D., during the reign of King Gyeongdeok, and was completed in 774 A.D during the reign of King Hyegong. Its construction was begun and completed parallel with that of Seokguram.



Silla Culture **Experience Center** 



Gyeongju National Museum is steeped in tradition. Representing Gyeongju, which was the capital city of the Silla Kingdom (BC57~AD935), the museum is where you can view the cultural history of Gyeongju district. #### Andong Hahoe Folk

This is a genuine historical site with people still living in and well-known for its traditional houses. The village boasts exquisite scenic sights: the elegant river flowing around the village, the magnificent cliff, endlessly unfolding sandy beaches, and lush, ancient pine trees. Also it was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List under the category of "Historic Villages in Korea" on July 31, 2010.



#### Hahoe Mask

This is No.121 National Treasure of South Korea, whose name was originated from Hahoe Folk Village. These masks are used in Mask-dance drama, Korean ritual-like drama with satire. The mask is one of the most beautiful image represening Korean culture.



**Byeongsan Seowon (Confucian School)** This is a Confucian School established by esteemed Confucian scholars to pay tribute to the memory of Seongnyong Yu who was well-respected for his writings and personality. In front of it, a river is situated. Cross the river and a mountain can be found. By forming a folding screen like shape around the school, the mountains both protect and add a serene beauty to the area.
